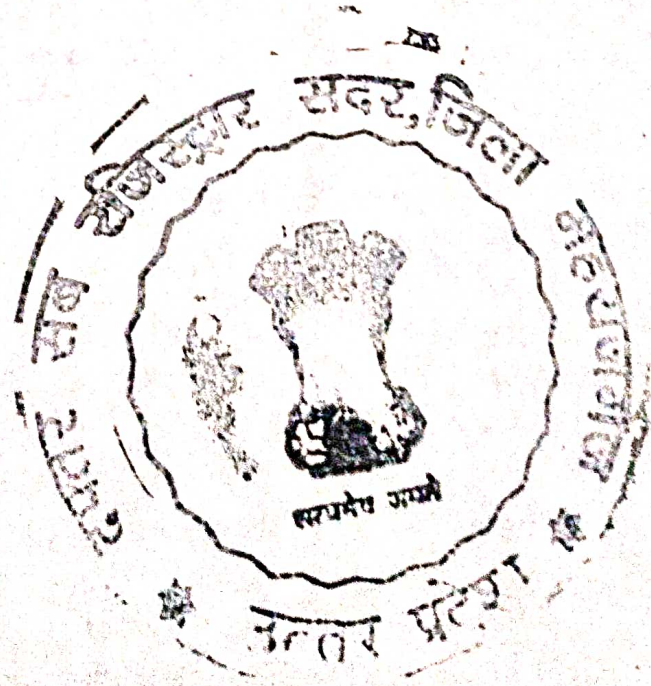

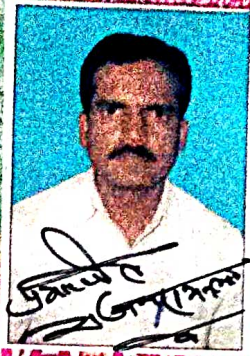

 - a. To establish and maintain schools, colleges, training institutes for all needy section of the society to provide quality education & training facilities to all specially destitute and disabled women and children anywhere in India.
 - b. Publication of literature for educational/health care cause and welfare programs for all community without any discrimination on the basis of caste, creed or religion.
 - c. To set up such other program and schemes which are in the interest of and betterment/up-liftment of the mass.

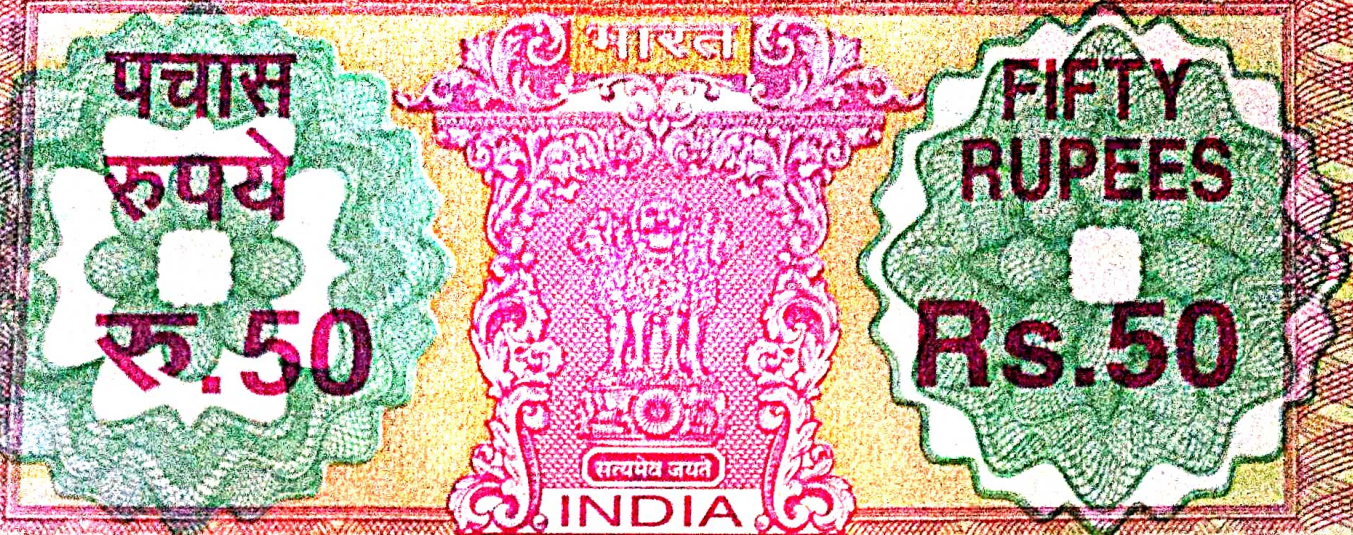

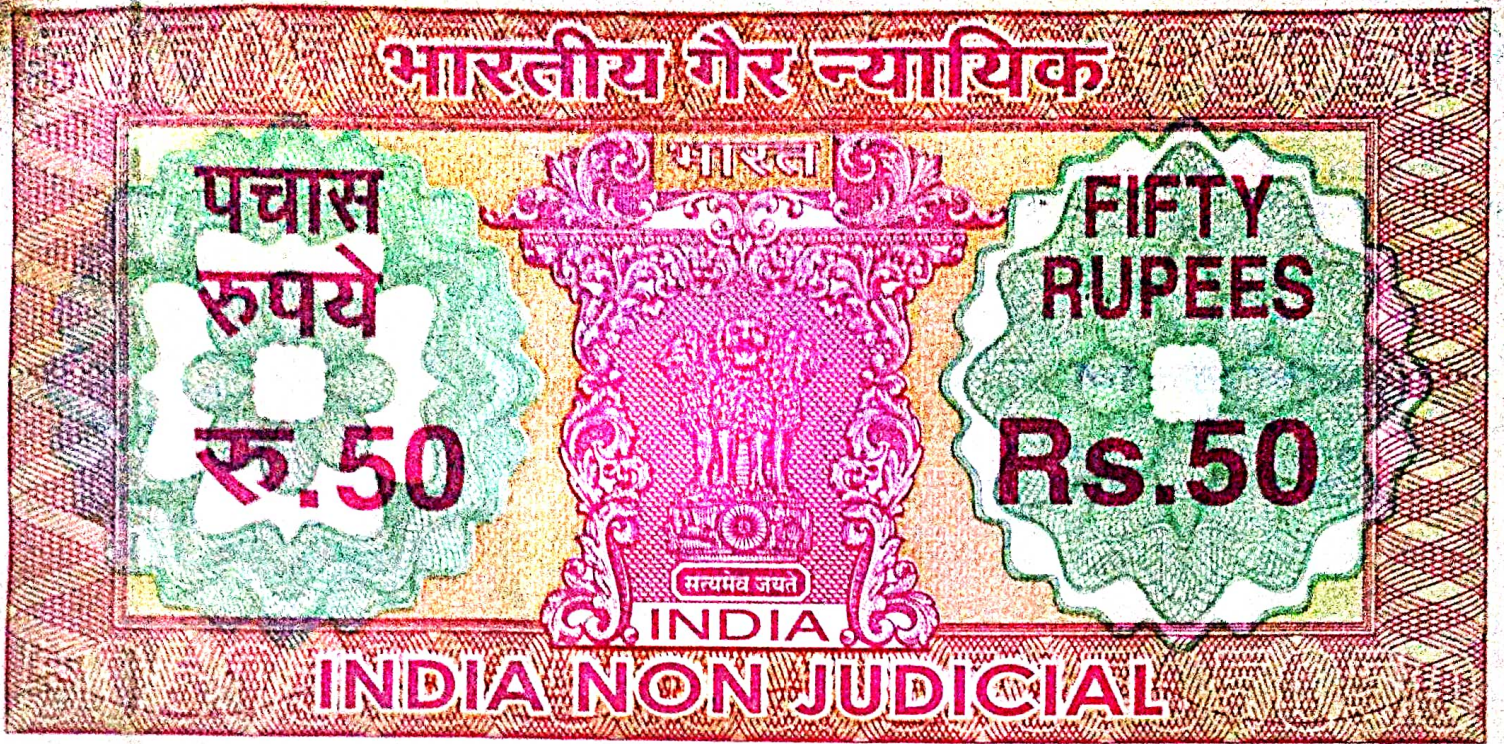
- 3- That office of the Trust is at Village Siswa Amahwa, Tappa Katahara, Pargana Haveli, Tehsil Sadar, District Maharajganj (U.P.); India and its branches may be in whole republic of India according to the need of the Trust.
- 4- That the aforesaid sum of Rs.10,000/- only shall hereafter be the 'Trust property'.
- 5- That the 'Trust Fund' shall comprise presently the Rs.10,000/- cash only at present without transfer of any immovable property and in future can be enhanced by means of subscriptions and donations and also:
 - a. Any other property and money, which the founder trustees may from time to time deliver to the Trust in future.
 - b. All moneys that may be provided by the State and the Central Government in future.
 - c. All fees and other charges received in future.
 - d. All money which is received by way of grants, gifts, donations, benefaction, bequests of transfer in future.

Provided that no benefactions shall be accepted by the trust which in its opinion involves conditions or obligations opposed to the spirit and objects of the Trust.

Any income generated in future by (a) (c) and (d) then that portion of the 'Trust Fund' comprising (a), (c) and (d) above shall from the 'Corpus of the Fund'.

That in fulfillment of the objects of the Trust, the Trustees shall be governed by the following provisions:-

- a. The Trustees may purchases lands and building to construct and maintain property in fulfillment of the charitable objects of the Trust and perform all ancillary functions.
- b. That trustees may accept gift of movable and/or immovable properties, money, charities etc. in fulfillment of and in consonance with the objects of the Trust, and may receive any property or lease, grant or otherwise.
 - (a) No part of the Trust Found including the gift receivable/ received shall be applied for any purpose which is not in furtherance of the charitable purposes and objects of the Trust.
 - (b) The trustees may convert the corpus of the Trust Fund from one form to another, without changing its basic character as capital assets and may invest it in such securities as are mentioned in section 20 of the Indian Trust Act, 1882.
 - (c) No immovable property of the Trust or that vesting in the Trustees shall be transferred without the orders of the court under Section 92 of the code of Civil Procedure 1908.
 - (d) Any College, school, training centers, or home of the trust shall be open to persons of either sex and of whatever races creed, castes or class and no test or condition shall be imposed as to religious belief or profession in admitting studepts, patients or persons and or in appointing members, teachers, administrative staff and workers or in any other connection whatsoever.
 - (e) May take steps to provide for instructions in different branches of education and to institute and conduct course for the advancement of learning and dissemination of knowledge in all such branches.

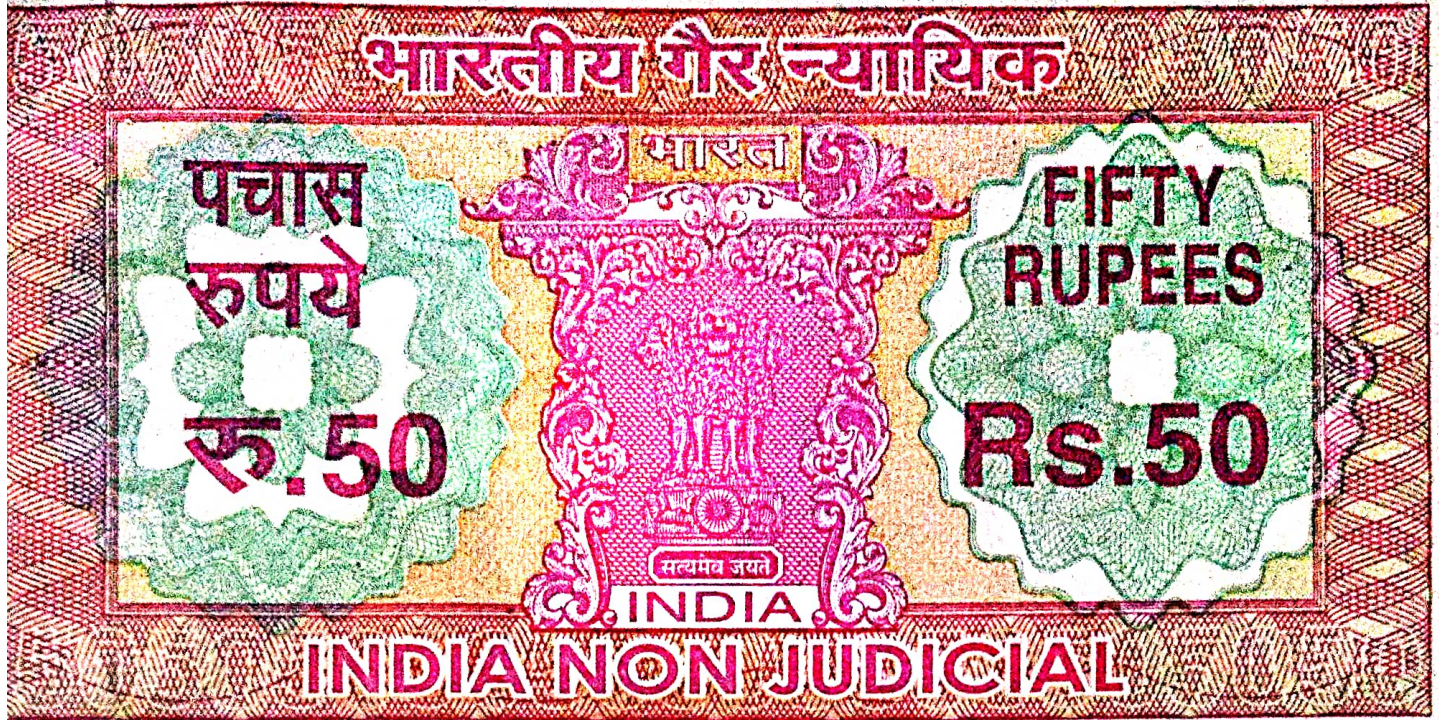

- (f) May fix and demand fees and other charges to meet recurring and nonrecurring expenses of any institution under the control, management and administration of the Trust.
- (g) May create full or part time teaching, administrative technical and ministerial posts on such wages, salary or remuneration which could be reasonable vis-à-vis the job requirements and may make appointments thereto.
- (h) May not allow any personal benefit to any or trustees otherwise than arising out of contractual obligation.
1. That for the management of the Trust and to liaise, coordinate and administer different units of the Trust there shall be a Directorate consisting of an Executive body to be named as, 'Managing Committee' of the Trust and the general superintendence direction and control of the affairs of the Trust and its, Income and property, movable as well as immovable shall be vested in it. The Managing committee shall comprise not more than seven members including founder trustees and their legal heirs and successors as the life members to continue the Trust directorate and the founder trustees of the trust shall be the Ex-officio members. The remaining three members shall be nominated by the founder trustee-cum manager.
2. That the term of office of the nominated member shall be one year from the date of nomination unless terminated earlier and a nominated member of the Managing Committee shall Cease to be a member if he dies, resigns, becomes of unsound mind or removed by the founder trustee-cum-manager. The founder trustee-cum-Manager shall be at liberty to fill up the vacancy by nomination another member in his place.

3. That the Managing Committee shall meet whenever the founder Trustees think fit and proper. The founder trustee/shall call meetings by giving written, notice to all members of the Managing Committee, who shall compulsorily met once in a year, but for smooth functioning of the Trust it will hold meetings once in three months, committee shall e contented by founder trustees on his initiative. For every meeting of the Committee at least fifteen days advance intimation shall be given! PROVIDED that in case of emergency the Manager/es may reduce the period of such intimation to an extent as they deem fit. Three members of the Committee shall constitute quorum for any meeting.
Provided further that if a meeting is adjourned for want of quorum, no quorum shall be necessary for an adjourned meeting.
4. That founder trustee/s shall preside over meeting and in his/her absence the other founder Trustee shall preside over, such member of the Committee shall have one vote and all other matters be decided by majority votes. In case of equality of votes the chair shall have exclusive right of a vesting vote.
5. That the agenda of the meeting of the managing Committee shall e intimated to the members before the meeting. Provided that a members may move resolution at a meeting of the Committee after giving information or one clear week or with the permission of the Manager of the person presideing over the meeting. The decision of the manager in regard to all question of procedure shall be final and binding.
6. That the minutes of the proceedings of a Meetings shall be kept. on record. All orders and decisions of the committee shall be authenticated by the founder trustees or any other person authorized by the committee in this behalf.

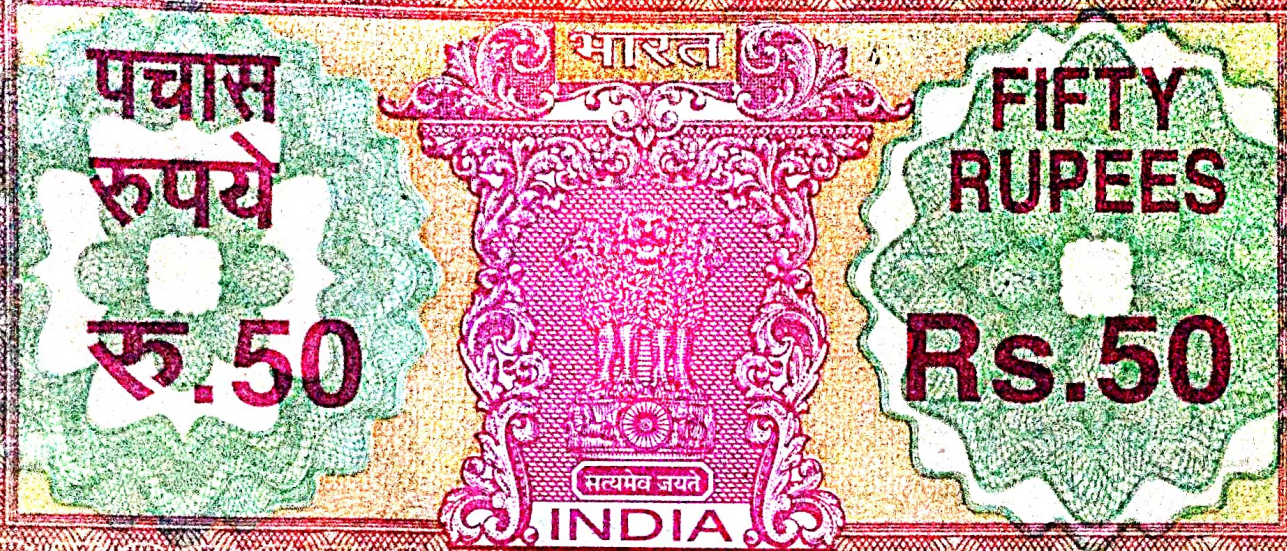

7. That the managing Committee by a resolution may delegate its powers for a specific purposes to any members of office of the Trust or its any unit or institutions to the extent it deems fit.
8. That the Managing Committee shall nominate anyone amongst the Nationalized Banks, Scheduled bank cooperative and Post office in India in which all money received shall be deposited. The account will be operated either singly through founder trustee/manager or jointly through founder trustee/manager and any one members of proper accounts of all receipts and disbursements of the Trust Found and its internal and annual audit by a competent Chartered Accountant.
9. That the managing Committee shall form time to time make rules regulation as and when bye laws as also amend or modify them as and when found expedient ad necessary for smooth conduct of its businesses.
10. That the founder trustee/s reserves the right to nominate any successor. Which right shall exercised only by a nomination duly made in writing whether testamentary or otherwise. An in case, any of the founder trustee dies Co-founder trustee shall become chief trustee and if the founder trustee dies Co-founder trustee shall become chief trustee and he or she will nominate the co-trustee shall become chief trustee and he or she will nominate the co-trustees. In case, both die at the same time without naming successor the first and nearest person as legal heirs shall become the chief trustee.
11. That the founder trustees of these presents at any time shall have powers to dissolve the Trust and to dispose of the assets and properties those belonging to the trust after discharging all the liabilities of the Trust as on that date. On

- conditions that such disposal of the assets properly shall be in conformity with the objects and prove of the Trust.
12. That the founder trustee shall have the rights to nominate his/her successor during his/her life time.
 13. That the schools, colleges, training centers and other institutions under the control and management of the Trust shall obtain affiliation, certification, permission or permits, necessary licenses form competent authority prescribed for the purpose, and the managing Committee shall take all possible steps to fulfill the conditions laid down by the concerned authority. The following provisions may also be kept in view and shall be complied with.
 - (a) That the Trust shall not generally ask for any grant or aid from the state Government.
 - (b) That the pay scale and other allowances of the trust employees shall not be less than pay scales and allowances applicable to Government aided similar Institutions unless permissible under any law in force.
 - (c) That the service conditions for staff shall be as per norms set by the concern authority.
 - (d) That the Trust shall comply orders and directions issued by the state Government from time to time.
 - (e) The records of the Trust shall be maintained in prescribed forms and registers.
 - (f) That no addition, alteration and modifications shall be possible in the aforesaid condition (A) to (F) without the prior approval of the concerned authority.
